The project will entail; Redesigning the physical space, raising the floor, deployment of server racks, networking, power configuration and management, precision air cooling, enhancement of fire detection and suppression, and implementation of CCTV and access control systems.

1. This Invitation for Bids (IFB) follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this project that appeared in Development Business, issue of **24th September 2010**.
2. The Kenya Civil Aviation Authority **has received credit** from the **International Development Association** toward the cost of Kenya Transport Sector Support Project and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this **credit** to payments under the agreement(s) resulting from this IFB: - **Contract for Remodeling and Modernization of Datacentre at KCAA Headquarters**.
3. The Kenya Civil Aviation Authority serves as the implementing agency for the project and now invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for:- **Remodeling and Modernization of Datacentre at KCAA Headquarters**.
Bidders **MUST** bid for all items. The summary of the required items/services are as follows:-
 - Removal of obsolete equipment at the site and deliver to the KCAA designated store.
 - Expansion, partitioning and reorganization of the datacentre
 - Raising the existing floor
 - Installation of a new ceiling, lighting system, and fire-rated doors
 - Supply and installation of server racks
 - Supply and installation of UPSs, AVR, power configuration and management
 - Supply and installation of precision air conditioning
 - Enhancement of fire detection and suppression
 - Implementation of CCTV, access control and datacentre monitoring systems
 - Support and maintenance of the site for three (3) years.
 - Any other configurations, services, training, equipment and accessories necessary to ensure full operations of the datacentre.
4. Bidding will be conducted using the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines that meet the following minimum qualification criteria:-
 - i) Bidders must have successfully completed at least three (3) contracts involving establishment of tier 2 datacentres. This should include the supply, installation and commissioning of equipment and works of similar complexity and value (Fire-rated partitions and masonry works, raised floor, power management, precision air conditioning, networking, and fire detection and suppression). Bidders are required to attach copies of the contracts/LPOs/LSOs and corresponding completion certificates/ recommendation letters from the clients.
 - ii) The bidder must have an annual turnover of a minimum of 200,000,000 KES for each of the last two (2) years. Bidders **MUST** attach approved audited Financial Statement for the recent last two years.
5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect bidding documents **during working hours from 0800hrs to 1700hrs excluding lunch time (1300hrs - 1400hrs)** at the office of the **Manager Procurement, Ground Floor, Wing A, Aviation House (KCAA Headquarters), JKIA, Nairobi**. Bidders may also view and download the bidding document from KCAA website: **www.kcaa.or.ke** or **www.tenders.go.ke** and immediately forward their particulars for records and for the purposes of receiving any further tender clarifications and/or addendums.
6. A complete set of Bidding Documents in *English* may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **KES 1,000.00** or an equivalent amount in freely convertible currency in cash or banker's cheque payable to Kenya Civil Aviation Authority. Bidders who download the tender document will NOT be required to pay.
7. A mandatory pre-bid and site survey meeting for all interested bidders will be held on 22nd May 2019 at **KCAA Headquarters, located at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport at 1100 hours**.
8. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 14th June 2019 **at 1100 Hours**. Electronic bidding **will not** be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at 1100hrs on 14th June 2019 **at KCAA Auditorium** located on **Ground Floor, Aviation House (KCAA Headquarters), JKIA, Nairobi**. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the form of a bank guarantee from a banking institution of **One Million Shillings (KES 1,000,000.00)** or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency.
9. The attention of prospective Bidders is drawn to (i) the fact that they will be required to certify in their bids that all software is either covered by a valid license or was produced by the Bidder and (ii) that violations are considered fraudulent, which is, among other remedies, punishable by potential blacklisting from participation in future World Bank-financed procurement.
