LAPSSET Corridor Development Authority (LCDA) is a Corporate body responsible for planning, coordinating and implementing the Lamu Port South – Sudan, Ethiopia Transport (LAPSSET) Corridor Program. LCDA was established in March 2013 through the Presidential Order Kenya Gazette Supplement No. 51, Legal Notice No. 58 and The LAPSSET Corridor Development Authority Order 2013. The LAPSSET Corridor Program (LCP), one of the flagship Vision 2030 projects, is a regional multi-modal infrastructure program integrating roads, railway and pipeline components in Kenya, South Sudan and Ethiopia. LCDA is seeking to recruit results driven and highly motivated individuals to fill the following exciting and challenging positions based at the following regions;

- 2. Regional Manager - Isiolo Region (1)**

Reporting to the Director General/CEO, this position is responsible for ensuring that the impact of the LAPSSET Corridor program is felt in the counties through which the LAPSSET Corridor traverses through community liaison activities and enhanced stakeholder engagement. Successful candidates will be based in Turkana and Isiolo regional offices. The Turkana Regional Manager will be in-charge of the Turkana and Baringo Counties and the Isiolo Regional Manager will be in-charge of Isiolo, Samburu, Meru and Marsabit Counties.

**Key Responsibilities include:-**

- i. Effective leadership and management of strategic socio-economic planning in accordance with the Authority’s overall mandate and strategic direction;
- ii. Effective coordination of the Authority’s social initiatives, program and projects;
- iii. Plan, prepare and facilitate national, sectoral and local communities consultations and dialogues with different LCDA stakeholders;
- iv. Develop a strategy for the improvement of stakeholder and public participation in LAPSSET Corridor Programs activities by the local communities, National and County Governments, Private sector, Youth and Women;
- v. Proactively identify political, social, economic and technical issues within the local communities;
- vi. Function as the link between LCDA and the local communities in proper and balanced representation of both parties interests;
- vii. Responsible for coordination of the LAPSSET consultancy services in the region;
- viii. Preparing reports and feedback on appropriate initiatives, community issues and relevant county legislation underpinning the development and implementation of the LAPSSET projects and reporting on issues affecting the area/region;
- ix. Workforce planning and management the Regional; and
- x. Any other task that may be assigned from time to time.

Successful candidates will be based in Turkana, Isiolo, Garissa regional offices.

**Key Responsibilities includes:-**

- i. Work closely with the Regional Manager in developing a strategy for the improvement of stakeholder and public participation in the LAPSSET Corridor Program activities by local communities, National Government, Private sector, Youth, Women, county Government;
- ii. Facilitate meetings and public consultations between LCDA and stakeholders;
- iii. Work closely with the Regional Manager to proactively identify political, social, economic and technical issues within the local communities;
- iv. Work closely with the Regional Manager in addressing issues affecting the local communities so as to properly present and balance the interests of both parties;
- v. Work closely with the Regional Manager to facilitate grass-root consultations with Authority’s stakeholders;
- vi. Assist in development and implementation of Re-settlement Action Plan;
- vii. Produce reports regarding activities undertaken and file quarterly with the Regional Manager;
- viii. Assist with developing material for engagement of stakeholders in general and specifically for target groups;
- ix. Ensure that stakeholder consultations follows guidelines for a participatory and equitable process; and
- x. Perform any other duties as may be assigned from time to time.
