Katibu Mkuu wa Elimu ya Msingi, Dkt Belio Kipsang anaonngeza kwamba, serikali itajenga maabara 2,000 za mtandaoni kusaidia STEM wanafunzi wafunzi wa JSS wakjiunga na Darasa la Grade 10

Serikali imetangaza mipango ya kujenga maabara 2,600 katika shule za sekondari kuanzia Januari 2025 kama sehemu ya maandalizi ya wanafunzi wa kwanza wa Shule za Upili chini ya Mtaala wa (CBC).
KKulingana na Katibu Mkuu wa Idara ya Serikali ya Elimu ya Msingi, Dkt. Belio Kipsang, maabara 1,600 zitajengwa katika shule za upili ambazo kwa sasa hazina vifaa hivyo. Serikali pia inapanga kuanzisha maabara 2,000 za kimtandao ili kusaidia elimu ya Sayansi, Teknolojia, Uhandisi na Hisabati (STEM) wanafunzi watakapojiunga na Darasa la 10 baadaye 2026.

“Tumejitolea kuhakikisha kwamba kundi la kwanza la wanafunzi wa Darasa la 8 litakapoingia Darasa la 10, kila shule itakuwa na angalau maabara moja. Kuanzia Januari mwaka ujao, tutajenga maabara 1,600 katika shule za upili zilizopo, ambazo wanafunzi wataingia 2026,” akasema Dkt. Kipsang.

“Tutaanzisha pia maabara 2,000 za mtandaoni, kuwezesha wanafunzi kushiriki masomo kwa vitendo katika maabara halisi huku pia wak-inufaika na teknolojia kupitia maabara za mtandaoni.”
Juhudi hizi ni sehemu ya juhudi pana za serikali za kuanzisha mifumo inayohitajika ili kuimarisha na kutekeleza kikamilifu mtaala wa CBC.

Waziri wa Leba Alfred Mutua ametangaza shughuli ya kitaifa ya kusajili Wakenya wanaotaka kufanya kazi nje ya nchi. Shughuli hiyo, itakayooanza Jumatano (kesho) katika Kaunti ya Machakos, inalenga kaunti zote 47 kufuatia nyingine ya hivi majuzi ambapo Wakenya 3,247 walijajiriwa na kampuni moja ya Qatar. Dkt Mutua alisema umuzi wa kuendesha shughuli hiyo katika kila kaunti umetokana na changamoto zilizokabili Wakenya wengi katika kusafiri hadi jumba la KICC na Chuo cha Kitaifa cha Ufundi cha Kabete. “Tuligundua watu waliitoka kila pembe ya nchi. Si haki kusafiri mbali huku baadhi yao wakilala katika vituo vya usajili. Badala yake tutawapelekea kazi hizo katika kaunti zote 47,” akasema.

Alisema nafasi hizo za kazi zitatolewa kwa mpango kuhakikisha kila kaunti imepata mgao wake wa haki.

Usajili katika kaunti utaendeshwa katika vyuo vya Mafunzo ya Ufundi (TVET) katika makao makuu ya kaunti. Hiyo itawezesha wanaotafuta kazi kufanyiwa majaribio ya ujuzi wao kulingana na kazi wanazotaka.

Dkt Mutua alisema maafisa wa Wizara wanaoongoza shughuli hiyo wataandamana na mashirika ya kuajiri yaliyoajiliwa na maafisa kutoka mashirika mengine husika ya

serikali, wakiwemo wa Huduma ya Kitaifa ya Polisi (NPS) na Idara ya Uhamiaji. Ushirikiano huo unalenga kuharukisha utoaji wa vyeti vya maadili mema na paspoti kwa watakaofaulu.

Shughuli hiyo katika kila kaunti, ambayo inalenga kuwapa kazi Wakenya wasiopungua milioni moja itaendeshwa kwa njia huru na wazi, na kutoa fursa sawa kwa Wakenya wote waliohitimu na wenye ujuzi.

Akihutubia wanao habari mjini Kisumu baada ya kuhudhuria kikao cha Kamati ya Idara ya Bunge kuhusu Leba, Dkt Mutua aliwataka Wakenya wanaotafuta kazi nje ya nchi wajiandae kwa kuhakikisha stakabadhi zao ziko sawa.

“Wakati wa shughuli ya usajili hivi majuzi, wengine walikosa nafasi kwa sababu hati zao hazikuwa sawa. Wengine, kwa sababu ya uchovu na njaa, hawakuweza kufanya vizuri,” akasema.

Akitoa taarifa ya hali ya utekelezaji wa Mfumo wa Elimu ya Msingi, Dkt. Kipsang alisema Wizara ya Elimu imeyarisha miongozo kuhusu jinsi wanafunzi wakavyojuunga na Darasa la 10.

Baada ya kumaliza mtihamu wa Darasa la 9 mwaka ujao, wanafunzi watasajiliwa katika kimojawapo cha vitengo vitatu ya kuendeleza masomo: STEM (kwa watakaofanya vyema katika Hisibati na Sayansi), Sayansi ya Jamii, au Sanaa na Michezo.

Dkt. Kipsang alisema serikali inalenga kuwapa wanafunzi wote fursa ya kuendelea na masomo ya STEM wanajiunga na vyuo vinavyozingatia ujuzi. “Usajili hautakuwa wa moja kwa moja kama hapo awali, ambapo alama pekee ziliamua shule anayojiunga nayo mwanafunzi. Wakati huu itakuwa zaidi ya alama na kuumuisha kitengo ambacho mwanafunzi amechagua,” akaelezea.

Wizara pia imetayarisha miongozo ya



usimamizi wa Shule za Sekondari, ikiwatambua walimu wakuu wa shule za sekondari kama wadau muhimu katika ku-tekeleza mtaala wa CBC.

“Tunajiandaa kwa mpito wa mwisho kutoka Darasa la 9 hadi la 10. Huu ni wakati mwafaka wa kujadili jinsi ya kusimamia mpito huu kika-milifu. Punde tu mitihani ya Kidato cha Nne (KCSE) ikimalizika, tutashirikisha wakuu wa shule kukagua na kuboresha miongozo hio,” akasema

Dkt. Kipsang.

Katika kukabiliana na uhaba wa walimu, Dkt Kipsang alisema wizara inaimarisha uwezo wa walimu na inashirikiana na Tume ya Kuajiri Walimu (TSC) kuajiri walimu wa ziada kwa Shule za Sekondari za Chini (JSS).

Wizara inalenga kuwa na zaidi ya walimu 90,000 katika mfumo wa JSS ifikapo Januari 2025, huku tukilenga kuajiri walimu 120,000.

“Tunafanya kazi kwa karibu na TSC kuajiri

walimu zaidi na kutathmini walimu waliopo wa shule za msingi ambao wanaweza kupandishwa hadhi kufundisha katika kiwango cha JSS.

Katika mwaka mmoja ujao, tunalenga kuwa na walimu wote walio na ujuzi unaohitajika,” akasema.

Katibu Mkuu alikuwa akizungumza katika Shule ya Msingi ya Gikanja, Kaunti ya Nyeri, baada ya kukagua maeleleo ya ujenzi wa vyumba vya Darasa la 9.

Serikali imetenga Sh2 bilioni kusambaza tani 97,000 za mbolea ya ruzuku kwa wakulima wa chai. Hatua hiyo in-
anuiwa kuzidisha mapato yao, kuwapunguzia ghar-
ama kwa wakulima na pia kuhakikisha wanapata pembejeo muhimu zina-
zohitajika ili kuboresha mavuno na ubora wa chai.
Akizungumza katika mkahawa wa Sarova Whitesands wakati wa mkutano wa kuadhim-
isha miaka 100 ya uuzaji wa chai wa Bodi ya Chai ya Kenya, Naibu Rais Ki-
thure Kindiki, alisema kwamba, katika miaka miwili iliyopita, serikali imesambaza tani 180,000 za mbolea ya ruzuku kwa wakulima kwa Sh2,500 kwa kila mfuko wa kilo 50.
Kuhusu changamoto nyingine katika sekta hiyo, Naibu Rais alisema serikali imepiga hatua kubwa katika kutatua masuala ya uongozi ka-
tika Shirika la Ustawi wa Chai Kenya (KTDA) kupi-
tia uchaguzi wa hivo ma-
juzi ambao ulileta uongozi mpya.

Aliongeza kwamba mageuzi ya kisheria na kitaasisi yanaendelea ili kuimarisha utendakazi wa sekta hiyo na kwamba hatua zifaazo zitachuku-
liwa ili kulinda maslahi ya wakulima.
Kindiki aliongeza kwamba marekebisho ya Sheria ya Chai ya mwaka wa 2020 yanaendelea, huku baadhi ya kanuni za chai zinazotakiwa ku-
tekeleza sheria hiyo zik-
iendelea kutayarishwa.
“Ili kulinda hadhi na sifa ya Chai ya Kenya na sekta hiyo na kuhakikisha uendelevu, serikali im-
eendelea kushughulikia changamoto zinazokabili uzalishaji chai, muhimu zaidi zikiwa gharama kubwa ya uzalishaji na utayarishaji, masoko, ukosefu wa thamani. kwa kuongeza, ubora wa chai na changamoto za kila mara kuhusu uongozi,” akasema Kindiki.
Alisema kipaumbele cha serikali ya Kenya Kwanza kuhusu kilimo ni kurahisisha uzalishaji badala ya utumiaji. Al-
iongeza kwamba mpango huo mpana unalenga kuimarisha mapato ya

kilimo, kuhakikisha us-
alama wa chakula, kutoa nafasi za ajira na kuongeza kuongeza mauzo ya nje ya Kenya.
Naibu Rais alisema chai ya Kenya inaaminika kuwa bora zaidi kote duniani kote kutokana na ubora wake, ladha nzuri na inaleta karibu Sh200 bilioni mapato ya kigeni kila mwaka, ambayo in-
achangia asilimia mbili ya Pato la Taifa (GDP). Inashikilia nafasi ya tatu baada ya mapato kuto-
kana na Wakenya walio ugenini na Utalii.
“Chai ya Kenya ni nguzo kuu ya uendelevu na uhifadhi wa mazingira wa nchi yetu. Pia ime-
saidia sekta ya elimu na uchumi wa vijijini kama chanzo kikuu cha map-
ato na ajira,” akasema Kindiki. Alitambua na-
fasi ya wanawake katika Sekta ya Chai, akisema wanachangia zaidi ya asilimia 60 ya uzalishaji wa chai duniani, na hivyo kuchangia kwa kiasi ki-
kubwa katika uendelevu, tija, na maendeleo ya jamii, hasa kwa sababu uzalishaji chai unahitaji kazi nyingi.

“Ukuzaji cha pia un-

Chuo Kikuu cha Taita Taveta (TTU) kimeanzisha mpango wa kuzidisha uwezo wa wachimbaji madini wadogo kote nchini.

Makamu wa Naibu Chansela anayesimamia Taaluma, Utafiti na Ushirikiano, Profesa Christine Onyango, alisema chuo hicho kimejikita katika kujenga uwezo wa wachimbaji madini wadogo ili kuboresha ujuzi wao wa kiufundi na usimamizi wa fedha ili kuongeza mapato yao.

Akizungumza katika hafla ya kwanza ya mpango huo mjini Kakamega, Profesa Onyango alisema eneo la Magharibi lina utajiri wa dhahabu, lakini mara nyingi wachimba madini wengi hunyonywa na wafanyabiashara wa kati ambao hununua madini yao ya thamani kwa bei duni.

Alifafanua kwamba, katika kukabiliana na changamoto hiyo, chuo hicho kikuu - kinachojivunia utaalamu katika uchimbaji madini na uhandisi wa utayarishaji - kimeshirikiana na wadau wengine kutoa mafunzo kwa wachimbaji madini wadogo katika masuala ya usimamizi na fedha, ili kuwawezesha kupata

mapato bora kutokana na kazi yao kwa kuongeza thamani.

“Mara nyingi wachimbaji madini wadogo huuza dhahabu yao ya thamani kwa wafanyabiashara wa kati kutokana na ukosefu wa maarifa na hawapati thamani ya mapato yao,” akasema Profesa Onyango.

“Wachimbaji wengi hawana ujuzi katika usimamizi, hawana ujuzi wa kutosha na wanatumia vifaa duni kuchima madini na kuhatarisha maisha yao,” akasema.

Bodi ya Dawa na Sumu (PPB), kwa ushirikiano na Huduma ya Kitaifa ya Polisi (NPS), imeanzisha operesheni ya kuondoa usambazaji, uuzaji wa jumla na usafirishaji wa dawa ambao haujaidhinishwa katika juhudi mpya za kuimarisha udhibiti wa dawa kote nchini Kenya.

Bodi imeelezea wasiwasi wasiwasi wake kuhusu usafirishaji wa dawa kwa magari maalumu ya usafirishaji, pikipiki na hata magari ya usafiri wa umma bidha leseni na idhini inayohitajika.

Aliongeza kwamba baadhi ya maeneo ya nchi yameshuhudia matukio ya hapa na pale ya itikadi kali yakiwemo yale ya Westgate, Mpeketoni, Chuo Kikuu cha Garissa, Dusit, na mkasa wa Shakahola, ambayo yanadhihirisha tishio

linaloendelea la maafa yanayochochewa na dini nchini.

Sheria mpya ya ushuru zilizopendekezwa zinalenga kukuza uchumi, kulinda usawa wa kijamii, na kuboresha maisha ya Wakenya bila kuwaongeza mzigo.

Msemaji wa Serikali, Dkt Isaac Mwaura, alisema kuwa katika muda wa miaka miwili iliyopita, ajenda ya serikali imetanguliza uundaji wa nafasi za kazi, usambazaji wa mapato, na uthabiti wa kiuchumi, ambayo yote yanalenga kusaidia unga ahadi yake ya kuunda mazingira ya kiuchumi ambapo Wakenya wote wanaweza kustawi.

Vita vya Benard Kemboi dhidi ya ulevi na juhudi zake za kuleta mabadiliko katika jamii



Bernard Kemboi, mraibu aliyepona akizungumza kuhusu utumiaji wa dawa za kulevya wakati wa warsha ya hivi majuzi ya kuadhimisha Siku ya Uhamasishaji wa Afya ya Akili Duniani Eldama Ravine, Baringo.

Bernard Kemboi ameshinda uraibu wa dawa za kulevya, akai-buka mshindi, na sasa ananua kutumia msaibu yake kuhamasisha wengine kuepuka tabia hiyo ambayo ilikaribia kumuangamiza.

Mwanamume huyo mwenye umri wa miaka 40 kutoka Kaunti Ndogo ya Eldama Ravine alieleza jinsi alivyokuwa mmoja wa Wakenya milioni tano wanaotumia angalau aina moja ya dawa, kulingana na ripoti ya NACADA ya 2022.

Huku kampeni ya serikali ya kupinga matumizi mabaya ya dawa ikisema watu wengi huanza kutumia dawa wakiwa na umri mdogo – kuanzia miaka saba hadi 20 kwa aina tofauti za dawa – Kemboi alitumbukia katika mtego huo katika mwaka wa mwisho wa ujana wake na akaendelea kwa karibu miaka ishirini.

Katika ulimwengu ambapo mvuto wa kukubalika na matukio mara nyingi hufunika hatari za matumizi mabaya ya dawa za kulevya, hadithi ya Kemboi ni kumbukumbu ya kuhuzunisha ya mstari hafifu

kati ya ujana na kukata tamaa. Kemboi, ambaye wakati mmoja alikuwa mwanafunzi mwenye matumaini na mustakabali mzuri, hatimaye alijipata katika makucha ya uraibu akiwa mwaka wa kwanza katika chuo kikuu.

“Nilikuwa mvulana mzuri hadi nilipojiunga na chuo kikuu,” Kemboi anakumbuka, macho yake yakionyesha maumivu na ustahimilivu. Alianza bila kukusudia katika sherehe ya wanafunzi wapya, ambapo msimko wa urafiki mpya ulipamba moto haraka na kugeuka kuwa maangamizi.

Akichochea na wenzake, alianza kutumia dawa za kulevya, akiamini kwamba zingeinua hadhi yake na kuji-aminini. “Waliniambia kwamba kadiri nilivyotumia ndivyo ningekuwa kama simba,” akaeleza, huku tabasamu la uchungu likipita usoni mwake.

“Nilihisi nilikuwa ninapo-teza kila kitu na singeweza kujisaidia,” – Kemboi

Kilichoaanza kama matumizi ya kawaida hivi karibuni kilibadilika kuwa utegemezi uliochukua maisha yake. Pole pole, Kemboi alijikuta amenaswa katika pingu za uraibu, akipanda hadhi kutoka kwa pombe hadi bangi na hatimaye kokeni.

“Singeweza kufanya lolote bila dawa za kulevya,” anakiri. Uhusiano wake na dawa ulizidi kuwa mbaya sana hivi kwamba madaktari walianza kutilia shaka afya yake kwa maneno ya kutisha. “Kila nilipokuwa mgonjwa, hawakuuliza kuhusu kileo kilicho katika damu yangu; waliuliza kuhusu kiwango cha damu katika pombe hiyo,” anasema.

Matokeo yalikuwa mabaya sana. Mizani yake ilishuka hadi kilo 36 tu katika kiwango chake cha chini kabisa. Alipoteza kazi yake ya kufundisha, na kibaya zaidi akapoteza kitu cha mwisho ambacho angeweza kushikamana nacho – familia yake.

“Nilihisi kama nilikuwa nikipoteza kila kitu kwani sikuweza kujizua tena,” akaeleza, uzito wa maisha yake ya zamani ukionekana katika sauti yake. Giza lililokuwa limemfunika lilionekana kutoweza kuzuilika, likimuacha

na hali ya kustaajabisha kwamba ana bahati kuwa hai.

Ni baada tu ya kugonga mwamba ambapo alitafuta msaada kutoka kwa Katibu Mkuu wa Ardhi Nixon Korir, ambaye alimunganisha na Wakfu wa Dorcas Rigathi. Alilazwa katika kituo cha kurekebisha tabia Bomet mnamo Januari.

Baada ya siku 100 katika kituo hicho, kutoka mizani ya kilo 36, Kemboi aliibuka sio tu amebadilika bali mtu mpya, mwenye mizani ya kilo 70.

“Hiyo ndiyo ilikuwa hatua yangu ya kubadilika,” anasema, akitafakari kuhusu siku 100 zilizopita tangu kuhitimu kutoka kwa mpango huo. “Nashukuru kwa nafasi ya kuanza upya.”

Leo, Kemboi anasimama kama kinara wa matumaini na balozi wa wanaopambana na uraibu wa dawa. Anatumia masaiibu yake kuhamasisha kuhusu ufahamu wa afya ya akili na kuhimiza wengine kutafuta msaada.

“Nataka kuwaambia walio katika hali kama hiyo kwamba kuna njia ya kutoka. Jiunge na kituo chochote cha kubadilisha tabia kilicho karibu nawe; hatua hiyo inaweza kuokoa maisha yako,” anasisitiza.

Mradi huo unaosimamiwa na Shirika la Huduma ya Wanyamapori Kenya (KWS), utatumia vifaa vya hali ya juu kufuatilia mienendo na afya ya vifaru weusi 178 katika Hifadhi ya Tsavo Magharibi.

Hifadhi ya Wanyamapori ya Ngulia ndiyo makao ya asilimia 90 ya vifaru weusi wa Kusini waliosalia ulimwenguni. wa Kusini; Asilimia 90 ya vifaru hao duniani wanapatikana nchini Kenya. Kwa hivyo, tunahitaji Wakenya kuelewa urithi tulionao, na kwamba uhifadhi ni mpango ambao hakuna anayefaa kuachwa nyuma. Wakenya wanaweza kushiriki tu ikiwa tutawapa habari na kuonyesha kile tunachofanya,” akasema Waziri.

Hatua hiyo inaangazia kujitolea kwa serikali katika uhifadhi na kutoa wito kwa sekta za umma na za kibinafsi kuchukua vifaru kama sehemu ya kampeni ya kitaifa ya “Tunza Mali Yako”, kuhimiza Wakenya wote kuunga mkono ulinzi wa wanyamapori.

“Wito wetu ni kwamba tunawaomba viongozi wetu katika sekta ya kibinafsi na ya umma kujitokeza na kuchukua wanyama wengine wengi, haswa walio hatarini ya kuangamia ambao tunawahifadhi ili sote tujifunze kwa pamoja na kuhifadhi urithi wetu,” akasema Kanga na kuwataka Wakenya wajiunge na mpango wa ‘Tunza Mali Yako’ akiongeza kwamba urithi ambao serikali imetoa kwa KWS ni urithi wa watu na kwamba kazi ya KWS ni kulinda na hifadhi.

Alisema: "Maono ya Uganda ni kubadilisha jamii kutoka kwa wakulima hadi nchi ya kisasa na yenye ustawi. Kwa hili kufanyika, tunahitaji kushughulikia baadhi ya masuala ya kimsingi na mojawapo ni umeme kisha ICT. Na pia tulitayarisha Ruwaza ya Dijitali ya Uganda 2040, ambayo tulifikiri ingekuwa lengo la kuleta mabadiliko,".

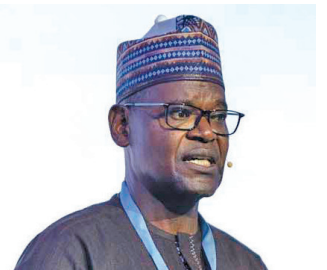

Jinsi Serikali inavyotimiza mipango ya maendeleo kupitia utekelezaji bora

Serikali za kisasa zinakabiliwa na shinikizo kubwa kutimiza matarajio na ahadi zilizozitokea mamlakani. Jukumu la usimamizi

wa utekeleza katika Serikali

Usimamizi wa utekelezaji unahusu kufuatilia kwa makini miradi muhimu ya serikali. Majukumu sawa yanapatikana kote ulimwenguni katika nchi kama vile Uingereza, Malaysia, India, Indonesia na Brazil. Nchini Kenya, GDU inasisitiza utekelezaji wa ahadi zilizoainishwa katika Mpango wa Mabadiliko ya Kiuchumi wa Bottom-Up (BETA) na maagizo yaliyotolewa na Rais.

Kazi kuu za GDU ni pamoja na:

3. Kuimarisha Mawasiliano: Kukuza hali ya utekelezaji kupitia ushirikishwaji wa wadau na mawasiliano yenye ufanisi.

vya utekelezaji, mbinu, na mawazo yanayolenga matokeo. Dhamira yake ya msingi ni kuhakikisha kuwa ajenda ya maendeleo ya serikali inatekelezwa kwa ufanisi, kwanza kwa kuonyesha wadau mchakato wa utekelezaji.

Kufuatilia miradi na mipango ya serikali

Nguzo ya kazi ya GDU ni kuthibitisha ama “kukagua ukweli,” wa miradi muhimu ka-

tika ngazi za kaunti na kikanda. Hii inahakikisha usahihi wa data iliyoripotiwa na hutoa maarifa muhimu kwa watoa maamuzi ili kushughulikia changamoto za ndani na kuboresha mikakati ya utekelezaji. Kwa kufahamu kinachotekeleza mashinani, GDU hulinganisha mipango ya serikali na mahitaji na matarajio ya raia, kukuza uwazi na uwajibikaji kupitia ushiriki wa mara

kwa mara wa umma na njia mbalimbali za vyombo vya habari.

Ututuzi wa shida na ufuatiliaji wa muda halisi Ufuatiliaji wa muda halisi huwapa wadau wakiwemo wananchi na watunga sera - picha sahihi ya maendeleo ya serikali. 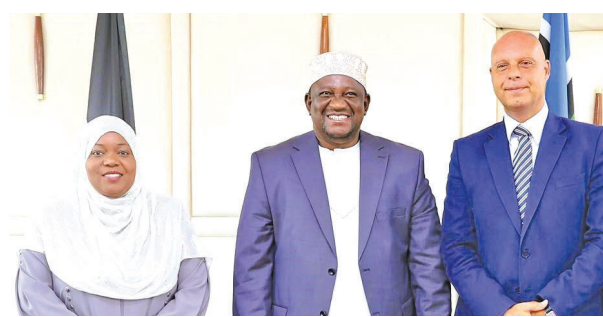
Mvurya alisema

“Tumejitolea kumaliza

Aliagiza Kamishna wa Kaunti ya Nakuru Loyford Kibaara kuongoza timu ya mashirika mbalimbali ya maafisa wa ardhi na wana-chama wa kamati, akiwapa jukumu la kuunda timu 17 katika vijiji 17 vya mpango huo ili kutekeleza uorodheshaji wa kina na uhakiki wa wakazi.

Mpango huo wa makazi, unaojumuisha karibu ekari 15,115, ulichukuliwa na serikali kupitia Wadhamini wa Hazina ya Makazi (SFT) kati ya 1999 na 2001 kutoka kwa Kundi la Makampuni ya Majani Mingi.

Awali ardhi hiyo ilikuwa ya mkonge, iliyonunuliwa kwa ajili ya kuhamishia makundi mbalimbali, wakiwemo waliokuwa wafanyakazi wa mashamba, wafanyabiashara na wafugaji.

Ugawaji wa ardhi wa awali ulifanyika mnamo Desemba 18, 2002, wakati barua za ofa zilitolewa kwa walowezi.

Hata hivyo, kufuatia malalamiko ya watu binafsi waliodai kutengwa, mgawo huo ulitenguliwa na aliyekuwa Waziri wa Ardhi.

Alitoa wito kwa Mwenyekiti wa Mamlaka ya Bahari ya Kenya, Khamis Mwaguya na Mkurugenzi wa Bandari Maritime Academy, Lewa Katana kutoa usaidizi wa kutosha kupitia ujumuishaji wa mipango ya Maritime katika vyuo mbalimbali vya kiufundi ili kutoa nafasi kwa kila mwanafunzi anayevutiwa na sekta hiyo.

Alisisitiza kwamba, kwa kukuza wafanyakazi waliojitayarisha vyema, wenye uzoefu, Kenya inaweza kujiweka vyema zaidi kama mshiriki wa ushindani katika sekta ya bahari duniani na kuimarisha kujitolea kwake kwa viwango vya juu katika elimu ya baharini na ajira.

“Hatuna wakati wa kupoteza, na kila taasisi inapaswa kuwa na uwezo wa kufundisha idadi ndogo ya mabaharia, kwa hivyo inabidi kupanua nafasi ili tuweze kutayarisha vijana wetu wengi kwa soko la ajira,” akasema Joho.

Ili kuhakikisha wanafunzi

wa STCW hawabaki nyuma katika masuala ya ajira, Joho alisema anashirikiana kwa karibu na idara husika ili kuhakikisha kwamba wanafunzi wanaweza kupokea Kitambulisho cha Baharini (SID) wanapohitimu.

“STCW inakuwezesha kupata kazi lakini ili kufika sehemu fulani lazima uwe na SID kwa hivyo aina ya mazungumzo tunayopaswa kuwa nayo kama mamlaka ya bahari ni jinsi tunavyoweza kusaidia wanafunzi kupata cheti hicho ili kuhakikisha hawaachwi nyuma nafasi za kazi zinapotokea,” akasema.

Aliongeza kwamba serikali imepunguza ada zinazotazwa kwa mafunzo ya STCW kutoka Sh35,000 hadi Sh15,000.

Mbunge wa Mvita, Mohamed Soud Machele, ambaye NG-CDF ya eneo bunge lake ilifadhili mpango huo alisema uwekezaji katika mpango wa STCW unaonyesha dhamira yao ya kufungua milango kwa vijana katika sekta ya kimataifa ya bahari.

“Kupitia mafunzo bora, wahitimu hawa sasa wamewezeshwa kuchangia uchumi samawati, ambao ni muhimu kwa Mombasa na ukuaji wa uchumi wa nchi,” akasema Machele.

Kwa upande wake, Gavana wa Kaunti ya Mombasa, Abdulswamad Shariff Nassir, aliangazia usajili ujao wa watu wengi kwa Mamlaka ya Afya ya Kijamii (SHA) katika kaunti hiyo.

“Baada ya siku sita, tutafanya usajili wa watu wengi wa nyumba kwa nyumba kwa mfumo wa bima ya SHA na kwa wasiobahatika, serikali ya kaunti bado itagharamia ada zao ili kuhakikisha wanapata huduma za afya za kutosha,” akasema Nassir.

Alitangaza upanuzi wa mpango wa “Skills Mtaani” katika maeneo mengine ya Kaunti ya Mombasa yakiwemo Likoni na Changamwe miongoni mwa mengine.

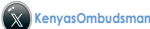
