“Tunatambua kuwa ushirikiano ni muhimu katika kukabiliana na changamoto katika mfumo wetu wa huduma za afya na kufikia UHC. Safari hii inahitaji kutembea bega kwa bega na washikadau huku wakitumia rasilimali zao, utaalamu na uvumbuzi,” akasema.

Dkt. Barasa alitambua wajibu mkubwa wa mashirika ya afya ya kidini, haswa katika maeneo ya vijijini, ambako taasisi hizi mara nyingi ndizo watoaji huduma wa afya wa karibu zaidi.

“Kujitolea kwenu katika kuhudumia jamii na kutoa huduma za afya ni muhimu sana. Ninawapongeza kwa juhudi ambazo mmeonyesha na kufanya kazi,” akasema.

Waziri alisisitiza mpango wa serikali wa kutoa

huduma za afya kwa usawa na za hali ya juu kwa Wak-enya wote, kuwalinda dhidi ya matatizo ya kifedha bila kujali mapato au maeneo yao.

Aliangazia maendeleo yaliyopatikana chini ya sheria nne za UHC zilizotungwa Oktoba 19, 2023: Sheria ya Bima ya Afya ya Jamii, Sheria ya Afya ya Kidijitali, Sheria ya Afya ya Msingi, na Sheria ya Ufadhili wa Uboreshaji wa Vituo.

“Sheria ya Bima ya Afya ya Jamii ya mwaka wa 2023 ilifuta Sheria ya Hazina ya Kitaifa ya Bima ya Afya na kuanzisha Mamlaka ya Afya ya Jamii (SHA), ambayo inasimamia hazina tatu muhimu. SHA ilianza kufanya kazi Oktoba 1, 2024,” akasema Dkt. Barasa.

Aliongoza kuwa, chini ya “Taifa Care,” serikali inatekeleza ahadi yake ya kuanzisha mfumo wa afya ya msingi unaofadhiliwa kikamilifu na umma.

“Kwa kujiandikisha na SHA, Wakenya wanaweza kupata huduma za afya ya msingi bila malipo katika vituo vya afya vya umma vya ngazi ya pili, tatu, na nne,” akasema.

Kenya na matakwa ya karne ya 21, ikilenga kukuza ujuzi, usawa, na ushindani wa kimataifa,” akasema Og-amba.

Rasimu ya Mswada wa Sheria ya Vyuo Vikuu 2024 inalenga kuimarisha taratibu za uidhinishaji wa kozi na taasisi ili kushughulikia masuala na vyuo vikuu vinsvyokiuka maadili. Mswada huo unagawa vyuo vikuu katika aina sita, na hivyo kuhitimisha mpangilio wa sasa ambapo taasisi hutoa mseto wa masomo.

Mamlaka ya ICT, Google, na wadai wengine wametangaza matokeo ya utafiti kuhusu manufaa ya mfumo wa dijitali Kenya 'The Digital Opportunity of Kenya', ripoti huru ili-yotayarishwa na kampuni ya Public First.

Ripoti hiyo inachunguza mabadiliko ya teknolojia ya kidijitali katika uchumi wa Kenya, ikifichua kuwa bidhaa na huduma za Google zilichangia wastani wa \$900 milioni katika shughuli za kiuchumi kwa biashara, mashirika yasiyo ya faida, wachapishaji, watayarishi na wasanidi programu nchini Kenya mwaka wa 2023.

Matokeo hayo pia yanaangazia nafasi ya Kenya kama kiongozi wa kidijitali barani Afrika na kusisitiza uwezekano mkubwa wa kuendelea kwa uwekezaji katika uchumi wa kidijitali.

Kuhusu Akili Bunifu (AI), ripoti hiyo inasema taaluma hiyo inaweza kuongeza \$2.4 bilioni kwa uchumi wa Kenya ifikapo 2030, ikisisitiza uwezo wake wa kurekebisha viwanda na kuunda fursa mpya kwa ukuaji.

Mkurugenzi Mtendaji wa Mamlaka ya ICT, Stanley Kamungu, alisema

mchango mkubwa wa Google katika uchumi wa kidijitali wa Kenya unaonyesha uwezo wa teknolojia kuendesha ustawi wa kiuchumi.

“Ushirikiano wetu unaoendelea na Google unalenga kufungua fursa zaidi za ukuaji na uvumbuzi,” akasema.

kufanya kilimo cha chai kuwa biashara yenye faida zaidi. Kwa hivyo, Njeru alitangaza kuwa KTDA itarudisha pesa zilizokatwa kutoka kwa wakulima juu ya bei iliyopendekezwa mnamo Januari, pamoja na malipo ya kila mwezi ya majani mabichi yaliyotolewa mnamo Desemba.

Aliongeza kuwa baada ya KTDA kukamilisha usambazaji wa mbolea mwishoni mwa mwezi huu, mamlaka hiyo itasawazisha hesabu hizo ili kubaini kiasi cha pesa ambacho kila mkulima atarudishiwa.

“Tutahakikisha pesa za kusitishwa kwa mbolea zinarudishwa Januari 5 pamoja na utoaji wa majani mabichi ya Desemba,” akasema.

Wakati huo huo, Njeru alitoa wito wa kukomeshwa kwa siasa katika sekta ya chai, akisema inaweza kuhatarisha sekta hiyo ambayo kwa sasa ndiyo inayoleta fedha nyingi za kigeni Kenya.

Idara ya Serikali ya Mifugo inaidhinisha ripoti ya uchunguzi yakinifu kuhusu mfumo wa malisho unaolenga kuboresha upatikanaji wa chakula cha mifugo katika kaunti 21 za Ardhi Kame na Nusu Kame (ASAL).

Utafiti huo unatarajiwa kuongoza wamiliki na wadau wa mifugo katika kutatua changamoto zilizopo, kwani uzalishaji wa malisho una uwezo wa kuongeza mapato.

“Sekta ya mifugo inachangia asilimia 12 katika Pato la Taifa na kuajiri zaidi ya asilimia 50 ya wafanyakazi wa kilimo,” akasema Mkurugenzi wa Uzalishaji wa Mifugo katika Wizara ya Kilimo, Bishar Elmi.

Akizungumza wakati wa warsha ya siku mbili ya uidhinishaji ya wadau katika hoteli ya Machakos, Bishar alieleza kuwa madhumuni ya utafiti huo ni kutoa takwimu na ushahidi ili kuhimiza uwekezaji kupitia mipango ya serikali au ushirika kati ya Sekta ya Umma na Binafsi (PPP). Uwekezaji kama huo, aliongeza, utaongeza mapato huku ukiimarisha uthabiti na uendelevu wa maisha katika mikoa ya ASAL.

PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON PROPOSED UPDATED MINIMUM TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR DVB-T2 RECEIVERS

The Communications Authority of Kenya (CA) is the regulatory agency for the ICT industry in Kenya with responsibilities in telecommunications, e-commerce, broadcasting and postal/courier services. CA is also responsible for managing the country's numbering and frequency spectrum resources, administering the Universal Service Fund (USF), as well as safeguarding the interests of users of ICT services.

The Kenya Information and Communications Act, 1998, mandates the Authority to licence and regulate broadcasting services in Kenya. In furtherance of the responsibility of promoting and facilitating the development of a diverse range of broadcasting services in Kenya in keeping with the public interest as provided for under Section 46A (a) of the Act, the Authority has proposed an updated minimum technical specifications and requirements for the second generation Terrestrial Digital Video Broadcasting (DVB-T2) receivers. The proposed update will ensure that only those digital receivers that comply with the current technical standards will be approved for use in Kenya.

Kenya adopted the DVB-T2 standard for terrestrial digital television broadcasting during the transition from analogue to digital television broadcasting in 2015. During the same period, the Authority issued minimum technical requirements for DVB-T2 Digital Set top Boxes (STB) and for Integrated Digital Television (iDTV) in order to facilitate availability of digital receivers locally for reception of digital terrestrial television transmissions.

The DVB-T2 technical specifications and requirements are therefore being reviewed in order to incorporate the technical enhancements that have since been introduced in terrestrial digital television broadcasting space. Upon implementation of the proposed upgrade of receiver specifications, television viewers will be able to enjoy new features that have since been made possible through the technological advancements on digital terrestrial platforms.

The objective of this current consultation on updated minimum technical specifications and requirements of DVB-T2 receivers is to allow stakeholders and the public provide feedback and suggestions on improvement of the proposed upgraded specifications and requirements for digital receivers.

Wakulima wa eneo la pwani wamehimizwa wakumbatia kilimo cha minazi iliyoboreshwa ili kuongeza mavuno na kukidhi mahitaji yanayooongezeka ya zao hilo.

Wadau wa sekta ndogo ya minazi, wakiongozwa na Taasisi ya Kusaidia Biashara Ndogo (MESPT) wanawataka wakulima kuachana na aina ya minazi mirefu ya Kiafrika yenye mavuno machache na kuanza kulima aina mpya ya minazi kutoka India.

Afisa Mtendaji Mkuu wa MESPT Rebecca Mukhoye alisema aina hiyo ya minazi ambayo kwa sasa inafanyiwa majaribio katika shamba la Nyuani, eneo la Mshongoleni, Kaunti Ndogo ya Malindi, inaweza kuzalisha kufikia nazi 350 kwa mti mmoja, ikilinganishwa na aina ndefu za Kiafrika zinazotoa nazi chini ya 50 kwa msimu.

MESPT, kwa ushirikiano na Shirika la Utafiti wa Kilimo na Mifugo Kenya (KALRO), Serikali ya Kaunti ya Kilifi, Shirika la Maendeleo la Kimataifa la Denmark (DANIDA), na Chuo Kikuu cha Pwani, wanatangaza aina hiyo mpya ya mnazi ambayo wanaamini italeti mabadiliko mazuri katika sekta hiyo ndogo ya kilimo cha nazi.



Akiongea katika shamba hilo la majaribio, Bi Mukhoye alisema mnamo 2019, shirika lake lilianza mpango na kaunti za pwani kuwezesha uagizaji wa minazi iliyoboreshwa. Wakulima karibu 200 katika Kaunti ya Kilifi tayari wamepitisha mpango huo.

“Tunachunguza uwezo wa kubadilika wa zao hilo na kushirikiana na KALRO, Huduma ya Uaguzi wa Afya ya Mimea ya Kenya (KEPHIS), na mashirika ya sekta ya kibinafsi katika eneo hili,” akasema. “Kilimo cha minazi iliyoboreshwa kimekuwa muhimu,

na wakulima wamepata mavuno makubwa kwa kila mti,” akaelezea.

Bi. Mukhoye alisema pia MESPT inaendesha kilimo cha nazi iliyoboreshwa kama njia mbadala ya wakulima wadogo ili kuongeza mapato kwa kila eneo na kuimarisha biashara ya nazi.

Ili kupunguza gharama za miche, MESPT inashughulika kuanzisha mitambo ya uzalishaji wa ndani ili kuepuka gharama kubwa zinazohusiana na kuagiza miche kutoka India.

Profesa Najia Mohamed kutoka Chuo Kikuu cha Pwani, na mwenyekiti wa

Aina bora ya mnazi unaotoa mazao mengi katika shamba la Nyuani, eneo la Mshongoleni, Kaunti Ndogo ya Malindi. Wakulima wa eneo la Pwani wamehimizwa wapande minazi iliyoboreshwa ili kuzidisha mazao kukidhi mahitaji yanayooongezeka ya nazi.

Kamati ya Ufundi ya Nazi, alibainisha kuwa mahitaji ya miche ya minazi iliyoboreshwa yanazidi uwezo wa sasa. Alitoa wito wa ushirikiano mpana na usaidizi wa serikali ya kitaifa ili kutoa miche kwa wakulima.

“Msaada wetu ni wa kuchochea sana;

Bei ya Sh2,500 kwa mche wa mnazi ulioboreshwa ni ya juu sana kwa mkulima wa kawaida

tunatoa msukumo wa awali, halafu serikali na sekta binafsi wachukue na kusambaza kwa wakulima,” akasema.

Afisa Mkuu wa Kilimo Kaunti ya Kilifi, Teddy Yawa, alitoa wito wa ushirikiano na serikali za kaunti zingine katika eneo la pwani kuagiza miche ya minazi iliyoboreshwa kutoka India, hivyo kufanya iwe rahisi kupatikana na kuwa nafuu kwa wakulima.

Alisema bei ya miche hiyo ya kati ya Sh2,000 na Sh2,500 kwa mche mmoja, haiwezi kufikiwa na wakulima wa eneo hilo, akisisitiza haja ya ru-zuku kutoka kwa serikali ya kaunti.

Bw. Rashid Kalu, ambaye Shamba lake la Nyuani ni mwenyeji wa mradi wa majaribio, aliripoti maboresho makubwa katika uzalishaji wa nazi, na hadi karanga 350 kwa mti kwa msimu. Aliwahimiza wakulima zaidi kukumbatia aina hiyo mpya.

Mjumbe wa Kamati Tendaji ya Kilimo Kaunti ya Lamu, Bw. Jams Gichu, alisisitiza uhitaji mkubwa wa minazi mashinani na kimaeneo, huku akiwataka wakulima kupitisha aina zinazokua haraka na zinazotoa mazao mengi ili kukidhi mahitaji hayo.

Alipongeza ushiriki wa sekta ya kibinafsi katika kusaidia wakulima wa ndani kuagiza miche kutoka India.

Serikali yaelezea upungufu wa data ya GBV huku utetezi ukianza

Unyanyasaji wa Kijinsia (GBV) ni janga ambalo linadhuru watu binafsi na kuathiri vibaya maendeleo ya pamoja ya Kenya, Mkuu wa Mawaziri Musalia Mudavadi amesema.

Mudavadi amesisitiza kuwa ni wajibu wa pamoja wa Wakenya wote kutetea usawa, na haki ya kila mwanamke, msichana, mwanamume na mvulana kuiishi bila woga na kunyanyaswa katika jamii.

Alisema kuwa GBV si suala la kibinafsi bali ni mgogoro wa umma unaohitaji hatua za haraka kutoka kwa watunga sera, viongozi wa jamii, watetezi wa vijana na mashirika ya kiraia ili kutokomeza uovu huo, ambao unaathiri nchi zilizoendelea na zinazoendelea.

“Tunakusanyika hapa kwa mshikamano, kutoka mijini hadi vijijini, ili kutoa ujumbe kwamba GBV si suala la kibinafsi lakini mgogoro wa umma. Hatua za haraka zinahitajika ili kuunda

ulimwengu usio na vurugu na ukandamizaji,” akasema Mudavadi katika hotuba iliyotolewa kwa niaba yake na Katibu Mkuu Aurelia Chepkurui Rono wa Idara ya Serikali katika Ofisi ya Mkuu wa Mawaziri. Hotuba hiyo ilitolewa katika Uwanja wa Michezo wa Unoa mjini Wote, Kaunti ya Makueni, wakati wa uzinduzi wa kitaifa wa Siku 16 za Kupambana na GBV.

Mkuu wa Mawaziri alieleza kuwa GBV inaendelea kutokea katika nyanja zote za kijamii na kiuchumi na kitamaduni. Alielezea dhamira ya serikali ya kutumia takwimu kutoka kwa mashirika mbalimbali ili kuongoza hatua za kuzuia na kukomesha aina zote za GBV katika jamii.

Mudavadi aliangazia matokeo kutoka kwa Kituo cha Kitaifa cha Utafiti wa Uhalifu, ambayo yanaonyesha kuenea kwa mienendo inayooongezeka ya unyanyasaji wa kijinsia katika mazingira ya familia, ukiukaji wa haki za watoto, kuongezeka kwa mimba za utotoni, na

kuongezeka kwa wanafunzi wanaoacha shule.

Pia alitaja kutofautiana katika uainishaji wa data, kunasa, na kuripoti miongoni mwa mashirika mbalimbali yanayoshughulikia GBV na ukiukaji wa haki za watoto nchini.

“Katika kupambana na GBV, matumizi ya data ni muhimu katika kutunga sera na afua zi-

nazohitajika kukomesha aina zote za ukatili wa kijinsia. Serikali imejipanga kutumia takwimu zinazokusanywa na mashirika mbalimbali ili kuongoza uwekezaji katika hatua za kuzuia,” akasema.

Kulingana na Utafiti wa Idadi ya Watu nchini Kenya 2022, kitaifa, asilimia 34 ya wanawake wamekumbwa na ukatili wa kijinsia ikilinganishwa na asilimia 27 ya wanaume walioathiriwa na ukatili wa kijinsia.

Utafiti huo pia ulisema wanawake wenye umri wa kati ya miaka 45 hadi 49 wana uzoefu mkubwa wa ukatili wa kijinsia ambao wengi wao ni asilimia 42 ambapo katika Makueni visa vya ukatili wa kimwili viliripotiwa kuwa asilimia 22.7 na ukatili wa kijinsia asilimia 17.5 huku 6.3 asilimia hupata ukatili wakati wa ujauzito.

Utafiti huo zaidi unasema kwamba wanandoa au wale wanaoishi pamoja wanapitia kiwango kikubwa cha ukatili wa kimwili kwa asilimia 37 kwa wanawake na asilimia 23.5 kwa

wanaume nchini.

Kiwango cha ukeketaji wa wanawake (FGM) ni asilimia 15. Hata hivyo, ukeketaji huongezeka kwa umri kwa wanawake kati ya miaka 45 hadi 49 ambayo ni asilimia 23, utafiti unaonyesha.

Mudavadi pia alifichua kuwa serikali imejitolea kukomesha UWAKI kupitia mifumo ya kisheria na kisera kama vile Sheria ya Makosa ya Kujamiana, Sheria ya Ulinzi dhidi ya Unyanyasaji wa Majumbani, na sera ambazo zimejenga msingi unaosisitiza uwajibikaji na haki kwa waathiriwa.

“Tunajua kwamba sera lazima zitafisiriwe kwa vitendo, naomba vyombo vya sheria kutekeleza sheria,” alisema.

Alisema Sera ya Kitaifa ya Kenya ya Kuzuia na Kukabiliana na Unyanyasaji wa Kijinsia inakamilisha mkakati wa wanaume.

Waraka huo unasisitiza uzuiaji, ulinzi na usaidizi kwa manusura na unatafuta ushirikiano na mashirika ya kiraia.

Mpango huo uliozinduliwa katika makao makuu ya Shirika la Huduma za Misitu Kenya (KFS) eneo la Karura, Kiambu na kufadhiliwa kwa pamoja na serikali zote mbili, utaangazia mifumo ya ikolojia ya Mau, Aberdare na Mlima Kenya katika kaunti 14 zinazotambuliwa kuwa maeneo yanayokumbwa moto katika misitu.

Ni pamoja na Kiambu, Nyeri, Nyandarua, Muranga, Kirinyaga, Nakuru, Baringo, Kericho, Narok, Uasin Gishu, Bomet, Meru

Mradi huo ulizinduliwa na Waziri wa Ufaransa wa Ushirikiano wa Kimataifa, Thani Soilihi na Waziri wa Mazingira, Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi na Misitu Kenya, Aden Duale.

Jambo la msingi katika mpango huo ni wa Mtandao wa Redio Dijitali na mfumo wa Kugundua Video za Mapema za Moto

ili kuboresha utambuzi wa moto katika wakati halisi na kuimarisha uratibu wa kuushughulikia.

“Kuzinduliwa kwa Mtandao wa Redio ya Kijijitali wa Huduma ya Misitu ya Kenya na Kituo cha Kugundua Video za Moto wa Mapema Nairobi kunaasahiria hatua kubwa katika kuimarisha udhibiti wa moto wa misitu,” akasema

Duale.

Alisema mpango huo unasisitiza dhamira ya serikali ya kulinda misitu na viumbe hai huku akisisitiza juu ya nguvu ya ushirikiano wa kimataifa katika kuleta ufumbuzi endelevu wa hali ya hewa.

Duale aliongeza kuwa mradi huo unalenga kujenga uwezo wa kitaasisi kukabiliana na matishio ya moto wa misitu, na kuchangia katika lengo la kimkakati la Kenya la kufikia na kudumisha asilimia 30 ya miti kwa ajili ya utulivu wa mazingira.

Soilihi alisisitiza umuhimu wa ushirikiano wa kimataifa, akisema moto misituni ni changamoto inayoongezeka duniani. “Ushirikiano huu unaonyesha haja ya masuluhisho ya pamoja ili kulinda mifumo muhimu ya ikolojia,” akasema.

Kaunti ya Makueni yalenga kuzalisha tani 2.5 za kahawa

Serikali ya Kaunti ya Makueni inanua kuongeza uzalishaji wa kahawa hadi tani 2.5 katika muda wa miaka miwili ijayo.

Gavana wa kaunti hiyo Mutula Kilonzo Junior ameeleza kuwa serikali yake itasambaza miche 26,000 ya kahawa kwa wakulima kupitia vyama vyao vya ushirika vikiwemo Kikima, Kithangathini, Masokani na Kithumani.

Mutula alisema haya katika ofisi yake mjini Wote alipohutubia wanaahabari wakati wa hafla ya kukabidhi shehena ya kwanza ya miche 8,000.

Alisema miche iliyobaki itasambazwa wiki ijayo. “Tulikubaliana na wakulima kuwa kupitia mpango huu, tutaongeza uzalishaji wa kahawa hadi tani 2.5. Tulianza mpango huu mwaka jana, na nina furaha kuripoti kwamba wakulima wamevuna kilo 100,000 za kahawa bora,” akasema.

Gavana aliwataka wakulima katika maeeneo yanayolima kahawa wapande mazao mengi huku akisema kuwa nje ya nchi kuna soko tayari.

Aliongeza kuwa bei ya kahawa kwa sasa inafikia Sh87 kwa kilo, jambo ambalo litasaidia wakulima kupata kipato zaidi ili kupambana na umasikini.

Mutula alihimiza Idara ya Kilimo kuzidisha juhudi za kuelimisha wakulima kwa kutumia wataalamu ili kuwapa ujuzi unaohitajika kuimarisha uzalishaji wa kahawa katika kaunti hiyo. “Tunafaa kuhimiza wakulima kupanda kahawa zaidi kwa sababu kuna soko tayari nje ya nchi. Watu hawawezi kucha kunywa kahawa, na hili ni jambo ambalo linaweza kuingiza kipato kwa wakulima,” akaongeza.

Alifichua kuwa anashirikiana na serikali ya kitaifa Kahawa (NCPB) kuhakikisha wakulima wa kahawa wanapewa mbolea ya ruzuku.

Na Patrick Nyakundi, KNA
