REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENTS ON THE DRAFT CLIMATE CHANGE (CARBON TRADING) REGULATIONS, 2025 AND DRAFT CLIMATE CHANGE (NON-MARKET APPROACHES) REGULATIONS, 2025

Pursuant to Section 8(1) of the Statutory Instruments Act, Cap. 2A the Cabinet Secretary for Environment, Climate Change and Forestry notifies the general public that a Regulatory Impact Statement on the proposed Draft Climate Change (Carbon Trading) Regulations, 2025 and Draft Climate Change (Non-Market Approaches) Regulations, 2025 has been prepared to assess the impact of the Regulations on the public.

The Draft Regulations are made by the Cabinet Secretary pursuant Sections 36(1), (2)(bb) &(bd) of the Climate Change Act, Cap. 387A and they operationalize salient provisions of the said Act. The objectives of the Draft Regulations are to: provide a framework for the undertaking of carbon trading and related matters; and facilitate implementation and coordination of non-market approaches.

This is therefore to request the public and all persons likely to be affected by the Draft Regulations to submit written memoranda to reach the undersigned within **Twenty-Eight (28) days** from the date of publication of the Gazette notice.
