The National Drought Management Authority (NDMA) is a State Corporation established by the NDMA Act, 2016. NDMA is implementing the Dryland Climate Action for Community Drought Resilience (DCADR) Project, a four-year drought risk management initiative project, co-funded by the European Union (EU) and the Government of Kenya.
